The submissions of Mr. Majumder expressed a genuine intention on the part of his client. The interim order dated 1st December, 2015 is reinstated, with the variations and conditions mentioned below.

The writ petitioner will immediately by 31st July, 2016 make payment of a sum of Rs.25,00,000/- to the Provident Fund Authority. They will also continue to pay a sum of Rs.25,00,000/- every quarter, the first quarter ending on 31st October, 2016. The writ petitioner, under the supervision of the Provident Fund Authority will concurrently take steps for advertising the sale of the property, considering offers negotiating with purchasers but the writ petitioner will not be obliged to conclude any contract for sale of the properties in question, as long as they continue to pay Rs.25,00,000/- per quarter.

With the money received by the Provident Fund

Authority they might make interim payments to the

workmen concerned.

Liberty to apply to the writ petitioner or to the Provident fund Authority after 31st March, 2017 or if there is any default on the part of the petitioner.
